3. "Only people under the age of 25 are capable of learning anything new."		<b>C.</b> A person who discriminates against a particular group; treats them unfairly.
4. "All the American forces have been involved in torturing Iraqis."		<b>D.</b> A person who is biased against a certain culture; culturally biased.
5. "Only black people should be allowed to vote in the next election."		<b>E.</b> A person who is showing bias towards their own peer group.
6. "All white people are greedy and power-mad."		<b>F.</b> A person who is biased against people on the basis of their race, racist person.
7. "Women belong in the kitchen, not in the workplace."		<b>G.</b> A person who is biased against homosexuals; a homophobic person.
8. "I will only let my own age-group join any club I run."		<b>H.</b> A person who is against people of a certain religion; showing religious bias.

9. "Old people are just a burden on society, they contribute nothing."		<b>I.</b> A person who is showing bias by misrepresenting facts.
