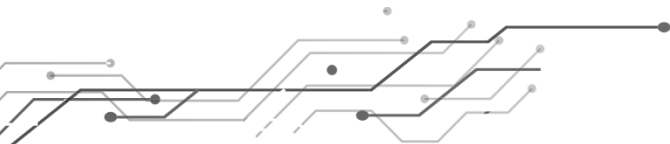

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS
